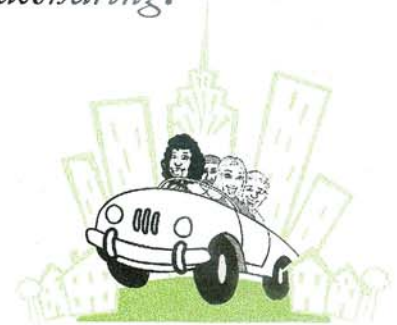
Did you know that if you participate in a carpool, vanpool or ride a bus, that you are already ridesharing?
